HOW exactly does this work and HOW do I sign up? And HOW else can I help? There will be announcements, tips and some surprises posted leading up to the tournament. Starting on September 1, grab a buddy, create a foursome or grab your league and play a round for Logan Strong. Keep track of your score and at the end, take a photo of your score card. Post your score on Facebook and either "check in" to the location, tag the location or add a photo of the course sign to your post. Don't forget you can do the same for mini golf! If you don't have Facebook, but still want to participate, or would rather stay "under the radar," the Facebook posts are not mandatory, but we will be doing some special prizes with our posts. Next, visit our website at www.LoganStrongFoundation.org and register your score. Registration (donation) is per person, per entry. You'll be asked some basic info, like name, where did you play, score, how many holes, etc. Once completed, you'll be able to pay right on the site.

However, you can enter as many times as you like, as many days as you like. There is no limit to the amount of entries! Continue to play through Sunday, September 30 and register before Midnight.

The Winners will be chosen based on scores for the Cash prizes. This is based solely on pure honesty, so if you team up with Tiger Woods or Michelle Wie and enter a rockin' score, PLEASE don't forget to include the photo together with them!
